Two uninvited visitors put a stop to golf

Georgie wins again

Georgie Seaman won her second successive winter stableford competition with 35 points. Gale McAuley was second with 29 points while Lyn Pell was a single shot behind in third spot.

On Saturday February 8 Tina Mulford extended her lead at the top of the ladies' winter league by winning the penultimate Round 9 with 37 points. Jane Brackenbury was second with 33 points while Gale McAuley took third place on 32.

With the winner based on the aggregate of the best five scores throughout the competition, Tina now sits on 177 points, 11 clear of Jane and 17 ahead of Gale and takes a virtually unassailable lead into the final round to be played on Saturday February 22.

Jane's tough challenge

It's not impossible for Jane to claw back the lead, but even if Tina scores less than 32 points and does not improve her total, our calculations show that Jane will have to score 42 points to draw level and so take first place on virtue of having the better last round. That's some ask though playing off a handicap of seven. All will be revealed next Saturday.
