Change of league and format for Scratch

Next week our scratch team entertains Feldon Valley Golf Club in our first game in the Oxfordshire Foursomes Scratch League having moved from the Reading and District Inter-Club Golf League at the end of last season.

This represents a change in format in that the matches will be foursomes rather than singles. The rules of engagement are that each match will consist of three foursomes games played off scratch from the tees determined by the home club.

One point will be awarded for each game won and half a point for each game halved. One bonus point will be awarded to the team that wins the match or half a point will be awarded to each team if the match is halved.

The competition is played in two sections and we will play in Section 2 alongside Badgemore Park, Burford, Feldon Valley, Kirtlington and Witney Lakes.

Our team will be captained jointly by Nigel Day and Greg Collins.
